Call to Order

- Commissioner Mike Lane called the meeting to order at 3:30 PM.

Approval of Minutes

- The minutes from the June 17, 2025, meeting was reviewed.
- Motion to approve made by Jo Rosenquist; seconded by Dr. Calderon. Motion carried.

Financial Report – Leone Anderson

- Reviewed the master grant list and noted the state fiscal year-end.
- Health expenditures were slightly higher due to year-end processing; time entries are keyed through the middle of the next month.
- July revenue will likely be lower because half was billed in June.
- Payment approval presented.
- Action: Motion to approve financials made by Jo Rosenquist; seconded by Don Chapman. Motion carried.

Health Department Reports Director's Update

- Darla from 3D Consulting presented for the board. Working with staff on billing. Several projects are underway, including review of the fee schedule for self-pay clients.
- Jacqueline talked about the upcoming boarding opening and presented changes to coordinate the bylaws with statute. John Bair was there to give history and statute explanation. Jo Rosenquist moved to approve bylaw changes; Don Chapman seconded. Motion carried.
- Ratified the BMTF grant: motion by Jo Rosenquist; second by Don Chapman. Motion carried.

Immunizations and Communicable Diseases

- Attended Immunization Summit in Glenwood.
- Scheduled “Back to School” walk-in clinics for August 1 and 8 (all day).
- Measles: Confirmed 1,309 cases nationwide — the highest in 30 years. No new cases in Colorado; Canada and Mexico are also reporting cases.
- Bats: Specimen from July 8 tested negative.
- Epidemiology: 9 animal bites reported.
- COVID-19: Slight increase in local cases.

Environmental Health

- West Nile Virus (WNV) Update: All local mosquito pools tested negative.
- WNV-positive mosquitoes identified in Adams, Boulder, Weld, Larimer, and Denver counties. Two human cases reported in Adams County.

Emergency Preparedness and Response (EPR)

- EPR/Epidemiology deliverables completed.
- Shirley and Mindy completed Wildland Fire PIO training and toured wildfire response facilities and equipment in Grand Junction.

- Commissioner Lane thanked Dr. Calderon for his service.
- Dr. Calderon expressed gratitude to all board members.
