Call to Order

- Immunization Program:** Jacque Davis
 - COVID-19 vaccines have been received.
 - Medicare is covering the vaccine; awaiting confirmation on private insurance coverage.
- Family Planning:** Kayleigh Addison
 - Conducted a site visit at the County Jail.
 - Met with contractor Pharma regarding ongoing services.
- Environmental Health:** Jacque Davis
 - Surveillance wrap-up completed for the season.
 - Six positive mosquito pools were identified in the Surface Creek area.
 - Staff attended the LEPC Mini Conference in Glenwood Springs and the Regional Radon Conference.
- Emergency Preparedness and Response (EPR):** Shirley Tatto
 - LEPC Conference: Discussion on forming a community committee for local planning under Homeland Security coordination.
 - Commissioner Don inquired about Public Health's role in hazardous materials incidents. Shirley clarified that the level of involvement depends on the location and nature of the event.
