Call to Order

Commissioner Mike Lane called the meeting to order at 3:30 p.m.

Approval of Minutes

Minutes from the previous meeting were reviewed.

Leone presented the financial reports, including:

Health Department Reports

Family Planning Program Update – Robin

Robin provided an overview of the Title X Family Planning Program. Delta County Public Health is a subrecipient of the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE), which receives federal Title X funding through the Office of Population Affairs (OPA). At CDPHE, the program is referred to as the Family Planning Program (FPP). The goal of Title X is to promote healthy families and allow individuals to decide the number and spacing of their children. Jody Roeber asked if undocumented can access these



services. Robin states that citizenship status of clients is not collected nor a requirement for these services to be provided.

Services Provided Include:

- Health education and counseling, including healthy relationships and abstinence
- Basic infertility services
- Pregnancy testing, counseling, and connection to care
- Screening, treatment, and prevention of sexually transmitted infections, including HIV
- Contraceptive education and supplies for all applicable diagnoses
- Limited physical exams, primarily gynecological
- Cervical, breast, and testicular cancer screening
- Referrals to health and social services

Funding Sources:

- Title X (Federal/State):
 - FY 2024–2025: \$23,036 federal and \$33,058 state, totaling \$56,094
- Community Services Block Grant (CSBG): Approximately \$40,000 annually
- Private Foundation Grants (Caring for Colorado):
 - Choose When: \$25,000 (July 2024–December 2025) for contraceptives for uninsured clients
 - ReproCollab Grant: \$125,000 (July 2025–December 2026) for partial salaries, supplies, equipment, and contracted services
- Insurance reimbursement and self-pay revenue

Environmental Health

Updates included:

- A variance is expected for a newly purchased property in Cedaredge.
- An Opt-Out Resolution for Greywater Systems will be presented to the Board of County Commissioners on December 9, 2025. Greywater systems are labor-intensive, require certified installation, and many residents have removed them due to cost and maintenance concerns.
- The 2026 Delta County OWTS Regulation Update timeline includes:
 - Stakeholder meeting
 - Press release
 - Submission of changes to CDPHE for review
 - Board adoption meeting, with adoption occurring 45 days later
 - Target completion by June 2026
- Permanent porta-potties are not permitted in occupied buildings and may only be used temporarily for construction, emergencies, or special events.
- Environmental Health will offer training and testing for homeowners installing their own OWTS (septic) systems.

Director's Report

- WIC program funding secured through the end of the year
- WIC Director job offer update
- Staff updates, including Jacque’s vacation and attendance at the CCI Conference
- Measles Update: Leah reported about reported cases in Montezuma County linked to an outbreak in Utah.
- Discussion regarding hospital OB closure impacts on services in Delta County
